CEO, Crossrail

Andrew Wolstenholme joined the airport operator BAA plc in 1997 as Construction Director for the Heathrow Express rail link. He went on to lead the delivery of the £4.3bn Terminal 5 programme and became BAA's Director of Capital Projects, running the £10bn development programme across seven UK airports. From there Andrew joined the Balfour Beatty Group in 2009 as Director of Innovation and Strategic Capability. Andrew joined Crossrail as its Chief Executive Officer in 2011. Andrew is Co-Chair of the Construction Leadership Council.

MIKE CLARKE
CEO, RSPB

Mike Clarke became RSPB CEO in 2010, and believes that the scale of the world's environmental challenge demands collective impact for common cause. He is a Global Council member of BirdLife International, the world's largest civil society partnership for nature conservation, spanning 120 countries. He was appointed by the UK Government to the Independent Forestry Panel in 2011, and is a member of the European Commission Better Regulation REFIT Platform. He has an MA Zoology and a PhD in Co-operative Award in Science and Engineering, with the Nature Conservancy Council, and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts.
