As an entrepreneur he founded two successful start-ups, including Intelligent Energy, the multi-award winning group, where he created ENV, the world's first purpose-built hydrogen fuel cell motorcycle. As a consultant he led international and emerging market teams for two of the world's largest global management consulting firms, Booz Allen Hamilton and AT Kearney, before becoming a Managing Partner with Deloitte.
