THE STEPHENSON CONFERENCE: RESEARCH FOR RAILWAYS

25-27 APRIL 2017, LONDON

In April 2017 the Railway Division will host the second international 'Stephenson Conference', dedicated to railway research. The conference will bring together researchers and industry experts to present, debate and develop their work.

The event follows the inaugural 2015 conference, attended by 138 delegates from **14 different countries** with 72 research papers and a further 10 case studies demonstrating how **research benefits the railways**.

Call for Papers:
