REVITALISING THE TYNE AND WEAR METRO

The Tyne and Wear Metro is a unique rapid transit system that originally opened in 1980, and now comprises 60 stations and 46 miles of route. Following expansion that encompasses elements of light rail, heavy underground metro and higher speed suburban operations, the system now needs updating.

This lecture will describe the delivery of the first programme of major infrastructure renewals, including how the Passenger Transport Executive (Nexus) has transformed the capabilities of its infrastructure team to become a capital project delivery team. Simultaneously the operating company, DB Regio Tyne & Wear, has led the refurbishment of the rolling stock fleet.

Richard McClean has been Managing Director of DB Regio Tyne and Wear, who operate Metro trains and stations on behalf of Nexus under a Concession Agreement, since 1 April 2010.
